

EXECUTIVE ORDER

Pursuant to Public Law 152, 81st Congress, and the amendments thereto by Public Law 61 of the 84th Congress, and by virtue of my authority as the Chief Executive Officer of the State of Arizona, I, ERNEST W. McFARLAND, Governor of the State of Arizona, do hereby establish and designate an agency of the State of Arizona to receive, store, distribute and in all manner, dispose of any and all properties declared by the United States Government to be surplus and given, sold or distributed to the State of Arizona, its political subdivisions or any other public agency, and/or any other institution, including private, non-profit, tax-exempt, educational or health institutions, declared by the United States Government suitable as a recipient of surplus property.

The said agency hereinafter designated is to receive from the United States Government all property presently or hereinafter designated as surplus property and deal with it in the manner prescribed by law under the direction of the Secretary of Health, Education and Welfare, his administrator or other designated agent.

It is the purpose of this Order to create an agency of the State of Arizona, subordinate to the executive authority of Arizona, empowered to cooperate with and otherwise deal in and with, surplus property distributed to the State of Arizona and its public institutions.


The said agency hereby created is to be known as the Arizona Surplus Property Agency and composed of the following designated officers of the State of Arizona, to-wit:



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
