Executive Order No. 2

Colonel John H. Martin, has expressed through proper military channels, his desire for retirement from the office of Colonel of the First Regiment of Infantry, National Guard of Arizona, and that he be placed on the retired list of officers of the National Guard of Arizona, as provided by Sec. 3198, Revised Statutes. The action requested is hereby ordered.

On this occasion the Commander-in-Chief desires to express, on behalf of the Territory of Arizona, due appreciation for the long and efficient service of Colonel Martin in the National Guard of the Territory.

Subsequent to eight years service in the National Guard of Missouri, he entered the National Guard of Arizona in May, 1890, as the first Captain of Co. D, 1st Infantry, at Tucson; in 1891 he was promoted Major; June 10, 1892, he was elected Colonel of the First Infantry and has held the position continuously since that time.
