AMENDMENT—CORPORATE CHARTER OF THE SWINOMISH INDIAN TRIBAL COMMUNITY, WASHINGTON

AMENDMENT I

Section 5 (b) (2), Corporate Powers, shall be amended to read as follows:

(2) No leases, permits (which terms shall not include land assignments to members of the Community), or timber sale contracts covering any land or interests in land now or hereafter held by the Community shall be made by the Community for a longer term than is permitted by law, and all such leases, permits, or contracts must be approved by the Secretary of the Interior or by his duly authorized representative.

This amendment, having been proposed by a resolution enacted by the Swinomish Indian Senate of the Swinomish Indian Community, Washington, on October 14, 1949, is herewith approved and submitted for ratification by the adult members of the Community living on the Swinomish Reservation in accordance with section 10 of the Corporate Charter of the Community and pursuant to the authority vested in the Secretary of the Interior by the act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
