Sadly, I've never been to Arizona.

Most of us have hurt for you all since we heard about this. Those of us who ever had family in this line of work, may feel it a bit more. It always hurts to lose a friend but to lose that many would be staggering to any group of people. It was really horrible that most were so young with small children.

I understand three wives were pregnant. I've enclosed one of the things I write for pregnant woman. If that would help, share it with them.

My husband and I have regularly prayed for you since I heard the horrible news.
