





TO HIS EXCELLENCY, LOUIS C. HUGHES, GOVERNOR:

SIR:

In compliance with the provisions of paragraph 2499 of the Revised Statutes of Arizona and amendment thereto, we have the honor to submit the following documents exhibiting the state and progress of the University of Arizona in its several departments, the course of study, the number of professors employed and students in attendance, and the amount of receipts and expenditures:

1. Copy of report of Dr. Theo. B. Comstock, President of the University Faculty, to the Secretary of Agriculture and the Secretary of the Interior, as required by act of Congress of August 30, 1890, in aid of colleges of agriculture and the mechanic arts.

2. Report of the Treasurer of the Board of Regents of the University of Arizona for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1893, as required by section 2 of the above cited act of Congress, showing receipts and expenditures, College of Agriculture, a copy of which report accompanied the above report of Dr. Comstock.

Report of the President of the institution to the Secretary of Agriculture and the Secretary of the Interior, as required by act of Congress of August 30, 1890, in aid of Colleges of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts.

I. CONDITION AND PROGRESS OF THE INSTITUTION, YEAR ENDED
JUNE 30, 1893.

The University of Arizona has grown materially during the year, and important changes in administration have been made. The scope of instruction has been much extended (to begin Sept. 27, 1893), so as to include work in Literature and Science, as well as in Art and Business courses. The endowment being very largely from the national funds, the work undertaken with such monies is chiefly of the character specifically indicated in the statutes relating thereto, for which free tuition is provided to both sexes. For the additional work, fees are exacted to cover the extra cost.
