

## OFFICIAL ACTS OF THE GOVERNOR

The Records of this Department, kept in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 2, Article 2, Paragraph 23, Revised Code of Arizona, 1928; show that the Governor has upon recommendation of the Board of Pardons and Paroles, granted 6 full and unconditional Pardons, 108 Commutations of Sentence and Paroles, Has issued 33 Holiday and other Proclamations; has honored Requisitions (22) from Governors of other States, for prisoners held in this State, has issued 24 Extraditions for prisoners held in other States, and wanted for crimes committed in this State. Has issued 623 Notarial Commissions, Made 82 Executive Appointments, Signed 77 Land Patents, 9 Deeds of Re-Conveyance, 8 Satisfaction of Mortgage, 9 Re-Assignment of Mortgage, 1 Assignment of Mortgage, 1 Deed of Relinquishment and 3 Loan Board Warranty Deeds.
