

INTRODUCTION

The Occupational Employment Forecasts are published annually for Arizona and each of its counties. The material provided in these publications was developed as part of the Occupational Employment Statistics (OES) program which surveys industries in all Arizona counties to determine their occupational composition. The information in the following tables is based on the results of those surveys.

The data reflect workers earning a wage or salary and excludes self-employed, unpaid family, and agricultural workers. Wage and salary employment represents more than 90 percent of Arizona's workers; however, the exclusion of workers not earning a wage or salary impacts certain occupations more than others. For example, employment of those earning only a commission (such as real estate sales agents) is not represented.

METHODOLOGY

Projecting occupational employment and demand is accomplished in two basic stages. First, staffing pattern ratios are determined by the OES surveys. These surveys are conducted on a three-year cycle, with one-third of all industries reporting in a given year. The response rate of Arizona's employers has consistently been above 90 percent. Next, industry employment projections are developed for the target years. These forecasts are computed using an econometric model driven by forecast values for variables such as national employment, interest rates, and inflation. Staffing pattern ratios are then applied to the industry employment projections to develop forecasted employment for every occupation in each industry.

Employment growth in each of the nonmetropolitan counties reflects the industry projections calculated for the "balance of state" (Arizona less Maricopa and Pima counties). Projected employment for the hospital industry in Yuma County, for example, reflects levels that would be attained if the county's hospitals were to expand at the rate that is predicted for all hospitals in the "balance of state." Projected hospital employment in turn determines the employment and demand for that industry's occupations, i.e., nurses.

LIMITATIONS

The occupational employment forecasts are based on the expected change from levels reported by employers in the OES survey. This methodology precludes the development of employment projections for newly established firms in industries that did not exist in a particular county at the time of the survey. The projection technique does not possess the degree of accuracy that may be implied by unrounded employment figures.

INTERPRETATION

Occupational data are presented in three formats: alphabetically, in OES code sequence, and ranked in descending order of employment.

Employment data represent the annual average for each specified year and reflects both full- and part-time workers. "Job Opportunities" indicates the estimated number of job openings (based on the annual average employment) for the period between corresponding months of the specified years. This represents the sum of openings, during the projection period, resulting from expansion and replacement. Expansion, or "Growth", is the numerical difference in employment over a given period. Replacement represents those job openings created by workers leaving the labor force and is based on occupational separation rates for Arizona. It is important to remember that "Job Opportunities" does not include labor turnover, which are openings created when workers change jobs, leaving the old positions to be filled by someone else. These vacancies are often the largest source of job openings.


