## 1 WHAT IS THE CANDIDATE'S EDUCATION AND BACKGROUND?

Morris Udall, 30, was born at St. Johns, Arizona. He received his education at St. Johns High School and the University of Arizona where he led his class in the College of Law and was president of the University Student Body.

## 2 DOES HIS RECORD QUALIFY HIM FOR THE IMPORTANT JOB OF SERVING YOU?



YES. As Chief Deputy County Attorney during 1951-52 he has handled all the major civil and criminal functions of the office and is acquainted with the problems of the Courts and the County Offices and Departments. He has had more than three years of general practice before Arizona Superior and Supreme Courts, and in the Federal Courts. He has handled a large amount of important trial work, and is widely respected among his fellow attorneys. He is on the Board of Governors of the Pima County Bar Association.
